Director Crocker stated that the quotes are for the same exact excavator (Lillegards has state bid) and recommended that the low quote be accepted. If was noted that cost will be split between Electric, Water and Wastewater Departments. Commissioner Martinson offered a motion to purchase an Excavator from Lillegards, Wahpeton, ND in the amount of \$71,400.00. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Graves and carried unanimously.

Co-Generation and Small Power Production Discussion/Resolution

Director Crocker informed Commissioners that the City is mandated to have a Policy in place that addresses green energy (solar, wind, etc.). If a Qualifying Facility (customer) would want to generate this green energy the Utility would have to reimburse customer for any unused energy monthly.
