**Appliances, lawnmower & snow blower:** Wilkin County Recycling drop off sight on County Road 14 (south lot), next to the horse arena

**Pallet, mattress, used construction material, grills, random items, garbage, debris, etc.:** Waste Management located at 1016 11th Ave South in Wahpeton. Open Monday– Friday from 8am–4pm. \$15 per load/visit up to 700 pounds (no electronic or appliances in this pricing; these items are priced separately). Items need to be placed by customer into large dumpster.

**Automobiles:** Contact Breckenridge Police Chief Karlgaard at (218)643-5506

**Old or junk iron:** Salvage yard or scrap metal dealer

**Grass clippings & Leaves:** Located at Pope Street; turn south at Favorites Deli on Minnesota Ave. (no bags, cardboard boxes or branches)

**Tree Branches:** Located 3 miles north on Highway 9, (turn right after the Head of the Red Trap Club), 3/4 mile to the east, site is on right side

THE CITY OF BRECKENRIDGE reminds residents that no person shall keep, deposit or store any debris on any premises within the City of Breckenridge, unless it is kept within a building. All debris kept, deposited or stored in violation of this chapter is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

Ordinances Chapter 103, defines debris as the following: Includes garbage, refuse, used or broken lumber, wreckage from buildings or other structures, used or broken or junked automobiles, trucks or dismantled parts or bodies thereof, piles of dirt or other material, and old or junk iron and other junk material. All vehicles and trucks which have not been in operating condition for a period of 30 days or more, shall be considered debris, as well as vehicles not displaying current state license registration.
