A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACTIVE LIVING COMMITTEE TO PROCEED WITH THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT NO. 311-19.

WHEREAS, pursuant to previous action taken, the City has applied for and been selected to receive funding for Safe Routes to School grants through the Minnesota Department of Transportation, with funding availability during fiscal year 2022.

AND WHEREAS, the proposed project consists of new sidewalks, school parking lot, street crossings and painting, ADA compliant crossings, speed feedback signs, beacons, pushbutton crossings, and auto gate to ensure the safety of the children to get to the various schools.

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to previous action taken, the City held an Open House at City Hall on June 28th seeking the public's opinion in regards to the overall project.

AND WHEREAS, after receiving no objections or opposition to the plan, the Active Living Committee is seeking authorization to proceed with the project.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota:

That the Safe Routes to School, Project No. 311-19, be it and is hereby authorized to proceed.
