

**RESOLUTION NO. 13100-93/2020**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN ENGINEERING PROPOSAL AND ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH ULTEIG ENGINEERS FOR PROJECT NO. 311-19, SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to previous action taken, the City has applied for and been selected to receive funding for Safe Routes to School grants through the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, with funding availability during fiscal year 2022.

**AND WHEREAS**, the proposed project could consist of new sidewalks, school parking lot, street crossings and painting, ADA compliant crossings, speed feedback signs, beacons, pushbutton crossings, and auto gate to ensure the safety of the children to get to the various schools.

**AND WHEREAS**, pursuant to previous action taken, the City has advertised for engineering proposals in order to select a qualified firm to design plans and specifications for the project.

**AND WHEREAS**, after receiving several proposals, the recommendation is to accept the proposal from Ulteig Engineers in the not-to-exceed amount of \$33,900.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota:

That the proposal from Ulteig Engineers is accepted and a contract be entered into for the Safe Routes to School Project No. 311-19, be it and hereby is approved.
