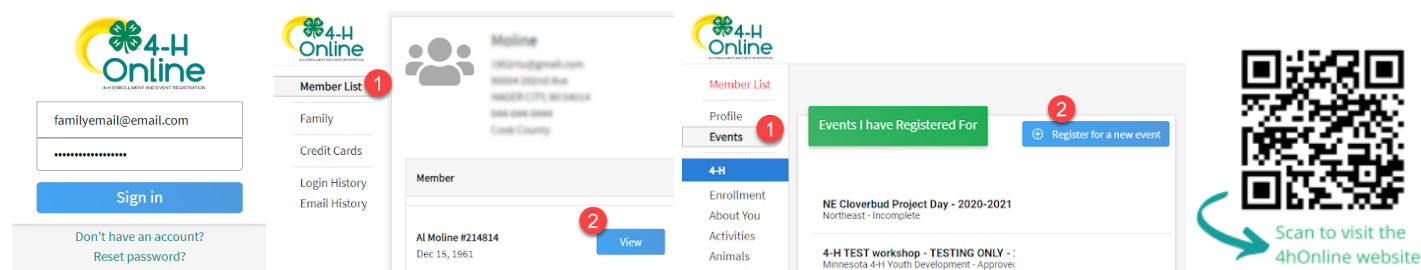

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How to enroll and register for an event



Step 1 (skip to step 2 if your child is already a member)

- Visit <https://mn.4honline.com> or scan the QR code at the top of this page.
- Log into your family 4hOnline account or create a new account if you are not an existing member
- After logging in to your family profile in 4hOnline, click on the Member List. Click 'View' on the member you would like to register
- Select "In-person 4-H Camp/Event" as your club
- In the projects field, select project areas based on your child's interests.
 - ◦ Cloverbuds (grade K-2)--choose "Cloverbud General" and/or "Cloverbud Animal"
 - ◦ 4-H Youth (grades K-13)--choose "Explore all of 4-H" or any of the project areas listed that your child will be interested in learning about
- Once your enrollment is reviewed and approved, you will be notified via email

Step 2

- **After receiving the enrollment approval email**, log back into your 4hOnline account
- Click on 'Member List' and view the member you would like to sign up for the event
- From the member's profile, click on 'Events' and 'Register for a New Event'
- Select the name of the event you are signing up for and the session/type you wish to register for
- Click 'Start Registration' and complete the registration questions as prompted
- If applicable, select the payment method to pay any fees that are associated with the registration. In some cases, you can use a Credit Card, but not all events are able to offer that option. In those cases please mail a check payable to Wilkin County 4-H to Wilkin County 4-H, 300 5th St, Breckenridge, MN 56520
- Click the 'Finish' button

Becoming a member

Completion of **enrollment** is required for participation in **ALL programs** to meet our risk management & safety of minors policy. If your *child is not currently enrolled in Wilkin County 4-H*, they will have to *enroll before you can sign up for an event or activity*. The steps outlined above will complete both your enrollment and event registration. This [enrollment guide](#) provides a more detailed enrollment step-by-step process.

Register for an event

Please note that registering for events will not be available until after your enrollment is completed and approved in 4hOnline. The enrollment review typically takes **24 to 48 hours for approval**. You will receive an email notice after the enrollment is approved. Now you can log back into 4hOnline to register for the event of your choice! 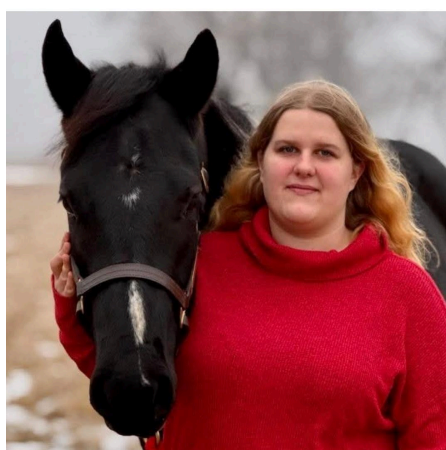

Safety policy for participation in all horse practices

All youth must wear closed-toe shoes with a heel (boots), jeans (leggings are not acceptable), and a t-shirt. A sweatshirt or light jacket is strongly suggested. All youth participating in mounted activities are required to wear properly fastened ASTM/SEI-approved protective headgear with chin straps. Helmet use is required when mounted.
