

## **URGENT – Your Help Is Needed!!**

Notice to Breckenridge Residents and Businesses:

Breckenridge Public Utilities (BPU) needs your help with identifying the type of water service line that supplies water to your residence or business. This identification of water service lines is **mandated by Minnesota Department of Health** (MDH). The objective is to identify which properties have <u>lead</u> service lines, so we can develop a plan to replace these lines. Currently, funding is available to help cover most, if not all, of the costs. Please look at the below photo (with more specific information on the back) to help you determine what type of service line you have.

2.Steel 3

3.Copper

4.Plastic

## Steps to Find What Service Line Your Property Has:

1. Find Your Water Meter and/or Water Shutoff: It will be located inside the property- in the basement, bathroom, crawlspace or even garage. It should be around 1 inch in diameter and enter the property from a few feet underground before connecting to the water meter. You'll see a valve on it, which looks something like these:








2. What material is the pipe (closest to the outside of property, example on photo to right) made off?

Black, White, Blue, Clear Your pipes are **Plastic** 



Not Plastic? Scratch the pipe: Use a key or coin to scratch the pipe close to where it enters the property through the wall, usually from a few feet underground. What color is underneath?





Silver or Gray & hard to scratch? Try a magnet on it—does it stick?

Yes, a magnet sticks. Your pipes are **Galvanized Steel**
