The funds received through this fundraiser would allow us to have a complete and consistent after-school program for the duration of the school year that parents and youth in our community need and can rely upon. While our community does provide a quality after-school program for youth through the 6th grade, that program does have a cost and is not available to youth above 6th grade. Our after-school program solves both of those age and socioeconomic issues. Since some of the youth that attend our program are part of the at-risk community, this program provides physical and social activities after school that many of them would not get otherwise. The beauty of this program is that it will be a success for all youth that choose to attend. This is because families are choosing to get our youth involved in a community program where they will be active, interact with others, work as a team,

and just take time to be silly and have fun! We also plan to track attendance to determine if additional advertising or changes to our program might be needed.

The suggested sponsorship fee is \$150.00, which will help us to maximize funds as well as offset any expenditures we incur from this fundraiser. This is just the suggested sponsorship amount, and any other amount, more or less, is greatly appreciated! Sponsors will be displayed on a tasteful banner so all who come to the Breckenridge Family/Teen Center can see who helped make a difference for our after-school program.
