Sept. 25th, 2024

You are receiving this letter because your residence **will** be affected by concrete work that is being planned for your street and cul-de-sac, starting tomorrow morning. The updated communication (we just heard this morning) is the concrete crew's will be back in town on **Thursday morning, Sept. 26th** to start installation of curb and gutter. After curb and gutter has set up (2 days), they will start to form and pour the driveways of the affected homes. They will be starting on Oak Street and then move to Fairway Ct. You **will be blocked** from your driveway for at least a week as the concrete cures. You **must** plan ahead and make sure you have your vehicles parked on an adjacent street/avenue as your street or cul-de-sac will be blocked off to traffic. Garbage trucks will not be allowed in the construction zones. Take your garbage to the dumpsters located on Main St. by the United Methodist Church.

The contractors work hours are from 6am to 8pm.
