

**RESOLUTION NO. 13126-21/2021**

**A RESOLUTION ORDERING PREPARATION OF A FEASIBILITY REPORT ON INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS ALONG NEW YORK AVENUE, RELATED TO THE SOUTH SIDE DRAINAGE FLOOD MITIGATION PROJECT NO. 308-17 PHASE II.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to previous action taken, the City entered into a contract with Interstate Engineering to provide engineering services for Project No. 308-17, South Side Drainage Flood Mitigation.

**AND WHEREAS**, this project will include the addition of storm sewer and complete street reconstruction from 6<sup>th</sup> Street South to 10<sup>th</sup> Street South along New York Avenue, with an alternate to include 10<sup>th</sup> Street South to 13<sup>th</sup> Street South along New York Avenue.

**AND WHEREAS**, the City is adding a project alternate that would include water and sanitary sewer improvements along a portion of New York Avenue in said project area.

**AND WHEREAS**, the City is considering assessing the benefited property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429,

**NOW THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota:

That the proposed infrastructure improvements for the South Side Drainage Flood Mitigation project along New York Avenue be referred to Interstate Engineering for study and that the engineer is instructed to report to the council with all convenient speed advising the council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.
