

WINTER PARKING NOTICE

No person shall park, place or leave any vehicle on any street or avenue in the City of Breckenridge, MN, on any day between November 1st—April 1st, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. - 6:00 a.m. Whenever the parking of such vehicle on such street or avenue will interfere with street cleaning or snow removal, Police will tow all vehicles that are parked on the streets in violation of the ordinance.

WATER CONSERVATION

Know where your master water shut-off valve is located and that it is in working condition. If a pipe were to burst, this could save gallons of water and prevent damage.

SUMP PUMP POLICY: If you would like to have your SUMP PUMP pumping into the sanitary sewer for the cold weather months of October 15th through March 15th, please call Breckenridge Public Utilities at (218)643-4681 to set up an appointment. There is a monthly surcharge of \$25.

Employees are authorized to do inspections of the sump pumps, etc. to determine if the connections are to the sanitary sewer or to the outside. If a property owner does not allow Utility employees to inspect, the surcharge fee of \$250 per month will be immediately applied until the inspection is made and determination that the sump pump(s), etc. is property plumbed outside.

Stop by City Hall to pick up a key. ***ONLY tree branches, leaves & grass clippings
