Weeds & Grass Ordinance §161-3:

Property Owners, Residents & Business Owners, it is YOUR responsibility to take care of the weeds & grass on your property. Any weeds or grass growing greater than 6 inches in height are a nuisance.

Junk & Debris Ordinance §103:

The City of Breckenridge reminds residents that no person shall keep, deposit or store any debris on any premises within the City, unless it is kept within a building. All debris kept, deposited or stored in violation of this chapter is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

1. Notify your local one call center by calling 811 (800-252-1166) making the request 2-3 days before work begins.
2. Wait the required amount of time for affected utility operators to respond to your request.
3. Confirm that all affected utility operators have responded to your request & marked underground utilities.
4. Respect the marks.
5. Dig carefully around the marked locations.



Why should I get a DOG LICENSE?

- If your dog gets loose, the Police Department will contact the phone number on the dog license to claim, before the dog is taken to the pound.
- To make sure the dogs are current on their vaccinations to ensure safety of residents and other animals.
- Help monitor what dogs are in the city.
- \$10 yearly dog license vs. \$100+ penalty for unlicensed dog.
