Census Bureau is NOW hiring in Minnesota

The Census Bureau is hiring hundreds of people across Minnesota for a variety of 2020 census-related positions, including recruiting assistants, office staff, operations supervisory staff, clerks, census field supervisors and census takers. The largest number of job openings are for census takers and there are a limited number of supervisory, clerical jobs, and recruiting outreach positions as well.

These temporary, flexible part-time positions are available in every county and pay between \$16 per hour and \$27.50 per hour (\$19 per hour in Wilkin County).

Job Qualifications

- Be at least 18 years old by April 1, 2020.
- Be authorized to work in the United States.
- Have a valid email address.
- Be available to work flexible hours, including some day, evenings, and weekends.
- Pass a U.S. Census criminal background check.
- Must be able to speak English well.
- Be registered with the Selective Service System, or have a qualifying exemption, if you are male and were born after December 31, 1959.

Some specific positions require employees:

- Have access to a vehicle and maintain a valid driver's license.
