

**RESOLUTION NO. 13128-23/2021**

**A RESOLUTION RECEIVING THE FEASIBILITY REPORT FOR IMPROVEMENTS ALONG NEW YORK AVENUE, RELATED TO THE SOUTH SIDE DRAINAGE FLOOD MITIGATION PROJECT NO. 308-17 PHASE II AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to previous action taken, the City entered into a contract with Interstate Engineering to provide engineering services for Project No. 308-17, South Side Drainage Flood Mitigation, Phase II.

**AND WHEREAS**, this project would include the addition of storm sewer and complete street reconstruction from 6<sup>th</sup> Street South to 10<sup>th</sup> Street South along New York Avenue.

**AND WHEREAS**, the City is adding a project alternate for the bid that would include water and sanitary sewer improvements along a portion of New York Avenue from approximately 8<sup>th</sup> Street South to 10<sup>th</sup> Street South in said project area for future development.

**AND WHEREAS**, the City is considering assessing the benefited property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429, and therefore had previously ordered a feasibility report to be done by Interstate Engineering.


**AND WHEREAS**, the report is hereby received by the City Council, and it provides information regarding whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.

**NOW THEREFORE**, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Breckenridge, Minnesota:

1. The Council will consider the improvements of such water and sanitary sewer service in accordance with the report and the assessment of abutting property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429 at an estimated total cost of the improvement of \$66,000.

2. A public hearing shall be held on such proposed improvement on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2021, in the council chambers of the City Hall at 5:00 p.m., and the City Administrator's office shall give mailed and published notice of such hearing and improvement as required by law.
