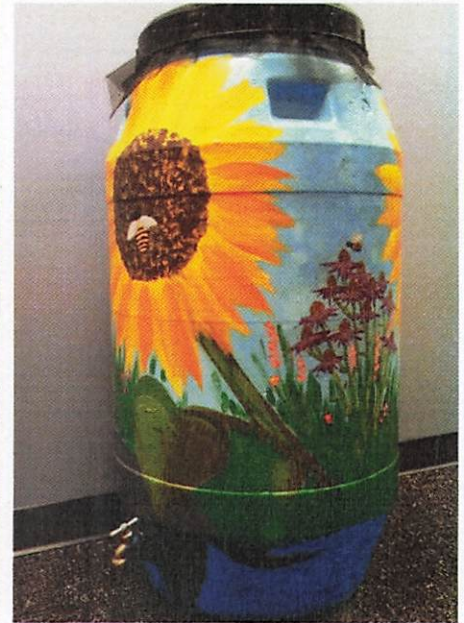

WHAT IS A RAIN BARREL?



A rain barrel is a system that collects and stores rainwater from your roof that would otherwise be lost to runoff. Our rain barrels are composed of 55 gallon re-purposed drums. They are inexpensive and easy to install next to any residential gutter downspout, and offer many great benefits for you and the environment.
