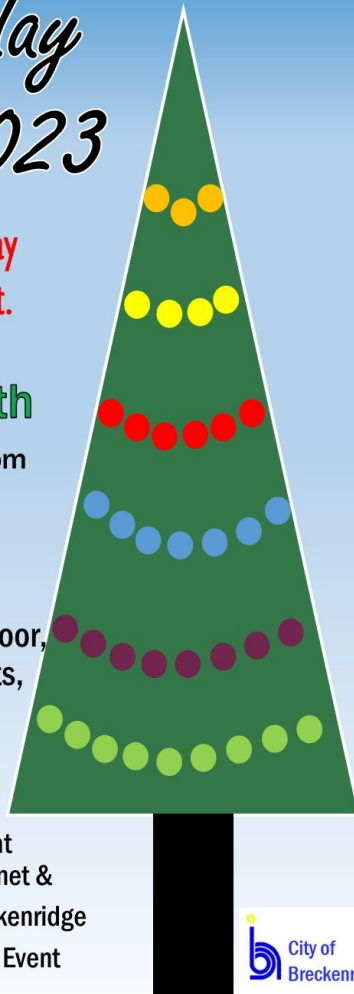

Leaf Drop-off Site is located at Pope Street. Turn south at Favorites Deli off Minnesota Ave. (No bags, cardboard boxes or branches) Bins removed when the ground freezes.

Tree Branch Drop Off Site is located 3 miles north on Highway 9, turn right after the Head of the Red Trap Club, 3/4 mile to the east, site is on right side.

(Not for household garbage! Organic material exclusively!)

*YOU NEED A KEY TO ENTER the Tree Branch Drop Off Site, due to illegal dumping. Stop by City Hall during business hours to pick up a key.



SUMP PUMP POLICY

Be prepared with your sump pump kit for the mandatory spring thaw sump pump switch over (deadline of March 31st)

A monthly surcharge of \$25 will be incurred by all residents who allow sump pumps, roof drains, drain tile or any other type of connection that allows rain, snow melt, or any other non-sewage water to enter the sanitary sewer system during the time period of October 15th thru March 31st. All customers **must** convert their sump pump(s) discharge to outdoor lawn or the storm water collection system by March 31st of each year.

WINTER PARKING NOTICE

No person shall park, place or leave any vehicle on any street or avenue in the City of Breckenridge, MN, on any day between November 1st—April 1st, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. - 6:00 a.m. Whenever the parking of such vehicle on such street or avenue will interfere with street cleaning or snow removal, Police will tow all vehicles that are parked on the streets in violation of the ordinance.

Know where your master water shut-off valve is located and that it is in working condition. If a pipe were to burst, this could save gallons of water & prevent damage.

The notifications will be used for things such as Past Due Balances, Electric/Water Shut Off's due to non-payment, Street/Water/Electric repairs & outages in your area. The system will only CALL the number on file unless you OPT IN for TEXT below.

Test your toilets for leaks at least once a year.

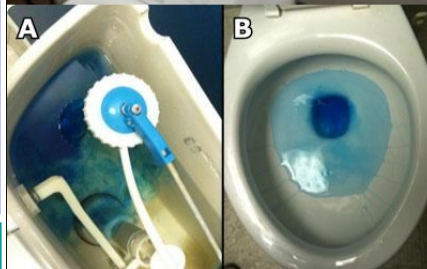
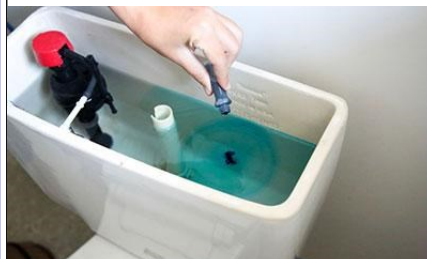
How to tell if your toilet is leaking:
