Fence Regulations

- Fence shall not exceed eight, (8) feet in height.
- Fences in front of principal building may not exceed three, (3) feet in height.
- Fences over six, (6) feet in height require a building permit.
- Fencing material is to be aesthetically appropriate and compatible for residential surroundings.
- Fence may be placed adjacent to, BUT NOT ON, a lot line
 - o Consideration should be given to snow removal along an alley.
 - o Consideration should be given to access for future maintenance lines.

At block corners, fences are restricted to chain link type, with minimum openings of 1-5/8 inches in the fence fabric and a maximum height of thirty, (30) inches within thirty, (30) feet of the property line intersections.
