You are receiving this letter because your residence will be affected by some utility work that is being planned for NE Breckenridge starting this Spring /early Summer. When started, the work will continue all summer and potentially into freeze-up. Scheduled work to be done will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Installing (burying) new primary underground wire.
- Replacing all existing distribution transformers
 - **Relocating some transformers from backyards of private property onto the City boulevards**
- Installing Secondary Pedestals (Junction Boxes) in the locations where some transformers currently sit on private property.
- Installing (on boulevards) several new switches to help with load balance and fusing.
- Boring and/or trenching in innerduct to protect the wire and allow for ease of replacement.
- Backfilling, leveling and seeding

Please be advised that this work will disrupt some resident's lawns and landscapes. We as a utility company will work closely with homeowners to minimize the disruption as much as possible but please understand that this work involves construction equipment and dirt work. Some residents will be impacted more than others depending on location. Additionally, as we need to relocate some of these transformers from back yard locations (private property) to the boulevards, some of these transformers will be more visible to some residence. I will personally be reaching out to those specific residents to discuss. All residents in the affected area will be notified to explain how this work will impact your specific residence.

Work is expected to begin around the first part of June.

NOTE: If you have a special planned event at your residence this summer such as: Graduation Party, Back Yard Wedding, Family Re-Union etc. where yard activities need to take place, please contact myself asap and we can work with you to try to schedule around your event.
